184. Angel Gabriel announces the virgin birth of Jesus to Mary - *Luke*

185-186. Jesus brings salvation to all nations – *Matthew*

187-188. Jesus says you must be born of the Spirit - *John*

189-190. Jesus' miracles prove His anointing as the Christ – *Mark*

191-193. The Pharisees plot to kill Jesus for accepting Gentiles



Jesus gives the Sermon on the Mount (196)

194-196. Jesus chooses 12 Apostles and instructs us with the Sermon on the Mount

197-204. The Pharisees blaspheme the Holy Spirit and John the Baptist is killed

205. Jesus says that you must partake in His flesh and blood

206-214. Jesus foretells His death and resurrection as the Sign of Jonah

215-220. God gives the Holy Spirit to Jesus' disciples

239. Jesus prays for His Father's name to be glorified and God answers

240-243. Jesus foretells the destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple

244-248. Jesus commands His disciple to love one another at the Last Supper

249. Jesus gives bread and wine to commemorate His sacrifice for many

250. Jesus promises to send the Holy Spirit to teach and comfort His disciples

251. Jesus says He is the True Vine and we must remain in Him to be fruitful

252-253. Jesus prays for His disciples and for those who will believe in Him later

254-257. Jesus is arrested for being the Christ and the Son-of-Man with power

258. Jesus is crucified to redeem us from sin and commends His spirit to God



Jesus Ascends to Heaven in the Sight of Many (264)

259-260. Jesus rises on the 3rd day and the guards are scared away from the tomb

261. Jesus appears to 2 disciples and explains all of the prophecies about Him

262. Jesus tells 500 disciples to baptize people of all nations and teach them

263. Jesus tells the disciples that they will be baptized in the Holy Spirit in power

264. Jesus ascends to heaven and the disciples praise God daily in the Temple

X. God's Promise Overcomes Persecution



Holy Spirit baptizes Peter and the disciples on Pentecost (265)

265. Peter and the disciples are baptized in the Holy Spirit in power - *Acts*

266-269. The Pharisees threaten the Apostles but miracles cause many to believe

270-271. Believers are persecuted but even Paul sees Jesus and believes

272. Gentiles become disciples and are called Christians at Antioch in Turkey

273-278. Paul takes the Promise through Cyprus and Turkey and many believe

279-281. Gentile disciples are not to follow Jewish laws – *James, Galatians*

XI. God's Promise Goes to All Nations



Paul Takes the Promise to Ephesus in Turkey (290)

282. Paul takes the Promise through Turkey again and into Europe

283. Paul tells philosophers in Athens that Jesus as God's Word will judge us

284-286. Paul teaches 1-1/2 years at Corinth and many become disciples

287-289. The disciples in Europe endure persecution – *1&2 Thessalonians*

290. Paul preaches at Ephesus in Turkey and returns to report at Antioch



Paul is Imprisoned in Rome (305)

291-295. Paul returns to Ephesus and teaches many in Asia for 2 years - *1 Corinthians*

296-297. Paul takes the Promise throughout Macedonia – *2 Corinthians*

298-299. Paul returns to Corinth and encourages the disciples in Rome - *Romans*

300-304. Paul goes to Jerusalem and is falsely arrested in Caesarea for 2 years

305-313. Paul is arrested 2 years in Rome – *Colossians, Philemon, Ephesians, Philippians*

XII. God's Promise Will Come True



Nero kills Peter, Paul and many Disciples (324 & 326)

314. Paul is released but Jesus' brother James is killed in Jerusalem - *Hebrews*

315-316. Paul takes Timothy to lead the disciples in Ephesus – *1 Timothy*

317-318. Paul takes the Promise to many new places and Crete - *Titus*

320-321. Christians are exiled in Turkey after Nero burns Rome – *1 Peter*

322-326. Nero blames the Christians and kills Peter and Paul – *2 Peter, 2 Timothy*



Glorified Jesus speaks to 7 Churches in Turkey (328)

327. False disciples come and the Romans destroy the Temple as Jesus foretold - *Jude*

328. Jesus helps 7 churches in Turkey and will come again to heal the nations - *Revelation*

329-331. John tells us that Jesus is God's Word of Life, God is Love, practice love – *1,2,3 John*

332. Jesus the Word is God and everything was made through Him - *John*

332. God Promises all nations that those who believe in Jesus will have life in His name
